**COMPETITION FOR THE CONFERRAL OF 1 COLLABORATION CONTRACT AT GREEN RESEARCH CENTRE OF UNIVERSITA' COMMERCIALE "LUIGI BOCCONI" OF MILAN, FINANCED BY EUROPEAN UNION**

*Article. 1*

The Università Commerciale "Luigi Bocconi" of Milan is launching a competition based on qualifications and tests for the conferral, by means of an appropriate contract, of 1 collaboration contract with the following characteristics:

Duration: 3 months

Research Centre: GREEN

Financed by: EUROPEAN UNION

Scientific Coordinator: Prof. Edoardo Croci

Research Project: CLimate- neutrality through Integrated Molecular model for urBan regeneration with sustainable finance (Grant Agreement no. SGA-NZC 101121530)

CLIMB is an Horizon project that will define and validate an innovative approach for climate-neutral urban regeneration in Milan and overcome systemic barriers to urban climate mitigation and adaptation policies. Within the project, innovative financing instruments will be designed and tested with the engagement of different stakeholders to close funding gaps and attract private capital for large-scale climate projects. The project also employs a scenario-based to track impacts and co-benefits, ensuring the long-term sustainability of interventions.

Bocconi University will contribute to all project activities, and specifically will conduct in-depth research to analyze and categorize financial, economic, and regulatory instruments for climate-neutrality, using best practices from national and international contexts; support measurement of impacts, co-benefits, cost-effectiveness, and financial sustainability; support the simulation of selected financial and regulatory instruments in the testing area; systematize conditions to foster a systemic city-wide approach of the model as emerged through co-creation activities; contribute to stakeholder engagement and dissemination activities.

**Job description:**

The research activity will focus on the analysis and design of innovative financial instruments for climate neutrality at local level. In particular, the candidate will contribute to the evaluation of financial instruments, provide support to the co-design of financial instruments and stakeholder engagement (e.g. survey, organization of engagement activities), and to collect and analyse data needed for the simulation of the financial instruments in the testing area.

The coherence of the university training path with the scientific-disciplinary sectors of the call and the topics covered by the announcement will be considered.

The candidate should demonstrate a good aptitude for research, excellent knowledge of both Italian and English (spoken and written), and willingness to travel within Europe. It is also necessary to possess the permits that allow working in Italy for extra-EU candidates for the whole duration of the contract.

## *Article. 2* *Admission Requirements*

In order to participate in the competition, the candidate must have the following requirements:

- Master's degree – Preferably in Economics or Finance

The candidate should have the following competencies:  
data analysis and interpretation

- data analysis and interpretation
- use of statistical packages (e.g.: Stata, R, Python, etc.)
- economic-environmental evaluation
- good ability to write scientific reports and papers.

The coherence of the university training path with the scientific-disciplinary sectors of the call and the topics covered by the announcement will be considered

The winner must, at the start date of the research contract, possess a valid work permit for research activities in Italy, for non-EU candidates, and for the entire duration of the contract, otherwise the employment contract will be terminated.

Relatives (up to the fourth degree of kinship) of professors in the University Council, the University Rector, or the Director General may not apply.

Candidates must be in possession of the above-mentioned requirements by the deadline for the presentation of applications as indicated in this advertisement.

Candidates may obtain conditional acceptance. At any time, the administration can arrange, within reason, exclusion from the selection procedure due to the lack of the necessary requirements.

## *Article. 3* *Applications*

Applications must clearly indicate:

- Name and surname
- date and place of birth
- fiscal code (codice fiscale)
- citizenship
- residence
- contact address
- qualifications

The application must include the following documents, which must be attached to the application:

- degree certificate(s), in pdf format;
- professional CV, in pdf format
- List of publications, if any, in pdf format;

#### *Article. 4* *Evaluation Committee*

The Evaluation Committee is composed as follows:

- 1<sup>st</sup> member: Director of the Research Centre or a representative
- 2<sup>nd</sup> member: Scientific Coordinator
- 3<sup>rd</sup> member: a person jointly appointed by the Director of the Research Centre and the Scientific Coordinator

The selection will be carried out by means of an evaluation of qualifications and an interview. The Committee can allocate a maximum of 100 points for each candidate:

- 30 points for the evaluation of the CV;
- 10 points for the evaluation of scientific publications and research project presented;
- 60 points for the evaluation of the interview.

In order to be admitted for the interview, candidates must receive a minimum of 25/100 points in the evaluation of titles and publications. The minimum total score required to be considered eligible and included in the final ranking list is 60 points.

Candidates will be informed of the interview date via e-mail, with suitable advance notice. Interviews may be held via conference call, or face to face at the University premises.

The Committee will evaluate the candidates and will rank these based on the scores obtained. The list will be valid until the end of the project, should the Scientific Coordinator wish to use the same list to recruit additional researchers.

Winning candidates will be notified in writing of the award decision. Candidates must sign the contract at the latest 15 days after receipt. The contract is individual and indivisible.

**Article.5**  
***Rights and Duties of the Contract Worker***

The contract will have a duration of 3 months and will likely start in June 2026.

Conferral of the contract implies a commitment to undertake research and dissemination activities at the university or any other contractually agreed location.

The normal obligations of the Contract Worker include:

- Research activity in the context of the Research Project, under the supervision of Prof. Edoardo Croci, Scientific Coordinator of the project who will assess the activity undertaken.

Activities undertaken outside of the scope of the contract, should not conflict with the contract with the University. The Director of the Centre will assess potential conflicts of this nature, following a consultation with the Scientific Coordinator.

Such circumstances will lead to the termination of the contract.

The conferral of the contract does not constitute an employment contract and does not confer any rights to teaching roles within the University.

**Article.6**  
***Financial Compensation***

The amount of the contract is €5.400 gross.

The University will provide accident and liability insurance cover.

Payments will be normally made in monthly post-dated instalments, following the submission, by the deadline indicated by the Administration Department, of a payment note signed by the Scientific Coordinator who will verify the activity undertaken.

**Article.7**  
***Causes of deferral or suspension of the contract***

If a candidate is on maternity leave, minimum payments will be made by INPS (national insurance) with a top-up payment made by Bocconi University up to the monthly amount of the contract.

**Article. 8**  
***Treatment of Personal Data***

All personal data supplied to Grants Office of Bocconi University will be used for the current evaluation procedure and for the conferral of a collaboration contract.

***Article. 9***  
***Advertising***

The advertisement of the above-mentioned position is published on the Bocconi University website. Bocconi University may also publish this advertisement on the main international job opening websites for this sector. A copy of this advertisement is available from the Grants Office.
